HOW TO GET TO THE RACE

TRAVEL ROUTE

The 20-Year Race takes place in Jordan which is centrally located in the world and easily accessible from Europe, North & South America, and even Asia.

The host town for the race is the historical town of Petra (Wadi Musa) – the actual name of the town around the UNESCO Heritage Site is called Wadi Musa.

The most common way to get to the host town of Petra / Wadi Musa is:

- 1. Fly into Amman the capital city of Jordan.
- 2. Take a 3-4 hour road transfer from Amman to Petra / Wadi Musa.

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS

You can fly directly into Amman from more than 60 cities in 36 countries so there are plenty of options. This includes various cities from most countries in Europe, the Middle East and Turkey which have great connections to the rest of the world, five cities in North America and one direct flight from Asia which leaves from Bangkok.

- Royal Jordanian is the national carrier of Jordan which has the most flights into Amman.
- For European flights, there are many airlines that fly into Amman including most national carriers, Royal Jordanian, and some budget airlines.



I have listed below the most common countries / cities with direct flights into Amman.

Travel websites such as www.cheapoair.com, www.kayak.com, etc. can be helpful to find the best route for you showing the routes which are shortest, cheapest and on different dates.

You can generally get flights in economy class from most places in Europe for under US\$1,000, from North America for under US\$1,500 and from Asia for \$1,500 to under \$2,000. However, these prices generally increase as you get closer to the travel time.

TRANSFERS FROM AMMAN TO PETRA / WADI MUSA

The best option is to arrange a private transfer which you can do by emailing info@desertparamours.net. The prices are below.

- The cost is per vehicle. If there is more than one person travelling, the cost will be split between the number of passengers.
- If you are travelling alone but would like to share transport, please mention this when you email Desert Paramours and they will help to find other volunteers or racers who are looking for a shared transfer at a similar time. If you would like your own vehicle, please also mention this when you make your booking.
- We may arrange a small bus at popular times but please contact Desert Paramours to make a reservation and we will ascertain the interest in a bus based on these bookings.
- Once your flights are booked, please also complete the <u>Logistics Form</u> and send in your request for a transfer to Desert Paramours early so that we can help to plan the most cost-effective option for everyone. If you need to make a change later this is possible.
